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BCeID Accounts for SD61 Employees

What is a BCeID?

A BCeID is an electronic ID issued by the Government of British Columbia that provides secure access to online government services. Individual citizens may have Personal BCeIDs, however, the government also issues Business BCeIDs to institutions including school districts to facilitate communication with various agencies and ministries.

I work with student data, do I need a BCeID as a school administrator, or office

personnel? When a BCeID is needed.

I need a BCeID to connect with services other than SADE, can you help me too?

The IT for Learning Department can help school district staff set up a BCeID account, and reset their password if necessary. We cannot connect individual BCeID accounts directly to the government ministries/services. SD61 employees need to access with the exception of SADE.
